Thank you for choosing to audition at our historic theatre! We ask that you sing only 16 measures of sheet music or a maximum of one minute of accompaniment without additional vocals on it. Acapella singing is not permitted.

At this time, The Playhouse is seeking to fill all roles during this audition process. As of now, callbacks may take place <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 1st through Saturday</u>, <u>October 5th as needed</u>. If you are called back, please <u>do not arrive more than 15 minutes prior to your given time</u>. The callback process is **closed to the public**. Your transportation may wait in the lobby or return to pick you up. If you are seeking a certain role and do not want to participate in the supporting company, please indicate that information on your application. If we do not "visually" see you in your desired role based on auditionees, we will not call you back. The Playhouse is looking for kind, hardworking, team first, physically adept actors and singers, with good physical hygiene, who can **fully** commit to helping to bring this beloved musical to our stage.

Please ensure your **telephone numbers** and **email addresses** are correct on your application. **You will be notified of the casting results by e-mail.** If you are needed for callbacks, we will call you. **Please check to confirm your voicemail boxes are clear and set up to receive messages.** If you have not received an e-mail regarding the casting results by **Sunday, October 6th at 4 PM** please contact us at 321-636-5050 and provide your audition number and letter. **DO NOT CALL BEFORE THIS TIME.**

On the application for this audition are questions related to double casting, understudying, and swinging (not performing unless called upon to). Performers should answer these questions honestly and truthfully, while maintaining transparency about any other needs (will only be cast with a fellow auditionee/conflicts/etc.) Statements alluding to/presenting indirectness, as well as vague responses (maybe/will discuss later/etc.), are strongly discouraged from being placed on the application.

Charlie and the Chocolate Factory is a physical storytelling adventure. All performers considering auditioning for this production should be in good physical shape. Most roles will require varying amounts of larger-than-life dancing and physical acting performance. Some performers may climb and perform on tall objects or wear costumes that are restrictive/large body with minimal visual or physical movement. The Playhouse is looking for kind, hardworking, team first, physically adept actors and singers, with good physical hygiene, who can **fully** commit to the upbeat, energetic, and colorful iconic characters with an understanding of comedy with truth and humanity. See below for more information regarding the character breakdown in addition to more information about being in the ensemble of this production.

The casting team of *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* is seeking to fill the role of Charlie Bucket by a performer of a similar age to the suggested age (9-13 years old). The four additional children, Augustus Gloop, Mike Teavee, Violet Beauregarde, and Veruca Salt are written with the intention of being portrayed by adult performers. While the casting team is open and will review young performers for these roles, it is highly recommended that all interested performers study and research U.S. Broadway performances and recordings of this musical to confirm their ability to bring these four characters to life. All adult performers are welcomed and encouraged to audition for these four roles as well.

Because of the needs of this show, it is impossible to cast everyone **All auditionees** are kindly asked to refrain from inquiring on the specifics of the casting process (why I wasn't cast, didn't receive a callback, etc.) as we are unable to provide audition critiques due to time constraints. If you are not chosen for this production, please audition again this upcoming season. All upcoming production and audition dates are available on our website at CocoaVillagePlayhouse.com.

If cast, rehearsals with the full company may begin as early as **Saturday**, **October 5**th or immediately following the casting decision. You will be given a schedule at the first rehearsal and will be required to submit an electronic copy of your colorized headshot at that time. If you do not have a headshot, we will provide you with further guidance on how to take and submit one.

We try to dismiss by 10 PM. There may be three times before we begin technical rehearsals that you may be asked to stay until 10:30 PM. We also rehearse on Saturdays during the day and will attempt to have limited rehearsals on Sunday afternoons. Your rehearsal schedule is driven by your placement in the show and the Playhouse's performance schedule. We will do our best to keep the schedule very organized. Your time is very important, and we will try our best to make your time at CVP productive. To help promote and educate our community on this production, there may be specific times where members of the company will be required to attend events throughout the area as well as special meet & greets or talkbacks prior to or following productions. We ask that you remain flexible and available with a positive mindset to assist with the ticket sales of this production.

Our technical rehearsals will begin with our design night on Monday, November 11th (Veteran's Day) and run through Thursday, November 21st. During the first week of technical rehearsals, we plan on rehearsing until 10:45 PM or later. During the final week of technical rehearsals, we plan on rehearsing until 11 PM or later. We will keep you continually updated during rehearsals of the dismissal time.

To be placed on the plaque this season as a GOLD STAR PERFORMER, you must perform in at least 4 of the 5 "Broadway on Brevard" productions this year. If you are not chosen for this production, we ask that you please audition again.

Listed below you'll find the performance dates and potential holdover dates for this production. Holdover dates allow for the opportunity to extend a show in the event of popular demand or provide flexibility if a show must be rescheduled for any reason. Please ensure that your audition application accurately reflects any conflicts for rehearsals, performances, and holdover dates. We do not want additional conflicts given to us AFTER you are cast unless it is an emergency.
