## STARS of Tomorrow

October 12, 13, & 15, 2026

Thank you for choosing to audition at The Historic Cocoa Village Playhouse and our STARS of Tomorrow Program! This program is designed to develop not only the dramatic and musical skills required for success in the performing arts, but also encourages scholastic and academic achievement to help create future leaders in our communities. For this audition, we ask that you sing only **16 measures** of sheet music or a maximum of **one minute** of accompaniment with no additional vocals on it. Acapella singing is not permitted.

Please ensure your telephone numbers and **email addresses** are correct on your application. You will be notified of the casting results by e-mail. If you have not received an e-mail regarding casting results by **Sunday, October 18<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM** please contact us at [Auditions@CocoaVillagePlayhouse.com](mailto:Auditions@CocoaVillagePlayhouse.com) and provide your name, audition number. Do not contact us regarding placement prior to this time.

If you are cast, our STARS orientation for parents and guardians will be next **Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 – 6:30PM for Grades 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, October 21<sup>st</sup> from 5:30 – 6:30 PM for Grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> and 6:30 – 7:30 PM for Grades 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>**. A parent or guardian is **required** to attend their respective STARS orientation to be placed in the program for Grades 1-8. STARS will be meeting simultaneously and will also be required to attend. Your placement in STARS for the duration of the program will determine the day of the week that your STARS group will meet. In general, elementary age children will be on Monday afternoons and middle schoolers and high school age children will rehearsal on Wednesday afternoon/evenings until we move closer to shows. You will be given a master schedule at the first STARS Orientation meeting.

There is a \$450 annual fee per child for STARS which is divided into two payments. **Payment plans are available based on financial needs if you are cast.** For families with multiple siblings in the program, the annual fee will be \$400 per student. This year, all STARS will meet throughout the entire length of the program through Summer 2027. The first few months will focus on training and education in all aspects and departments of theatre. As we prepare for winter holiday, we will then host internal auditions for the summer productions and reconvene in early January to begin rehearsals and further training.

Please note that in December/January, the ages for each group of STARS will vary based on the needs and casting of each production. Today's audition is to be a part of our general STARS season-long program and not for specific roles for our main shows in June. By signing your audition application, you understand and agree that if cast, it is your responsibility to be on time and attend rehearsals and performances. Excused absences may be obtained in advance from the Directors within a reasonable time frame. Unexcused absences, last-minute, or continued absences are not permitted and may result in removal from the program. It is also your responsibility to learn the material and be prepared for rehearsals and performances.
